

Tracks Installation Instruction

1. Use a flathead screwdriver to take off large bogey wheel covers, and use a 13mm wrench to loosen 2 bolts.



2. Pull out the large bogey wheels, and take the track off.



3. Use a 13mm wrench to loosen adjustment nut to adjust the track tension.



4. Next, use a 10mm wrench to adjust the track tensioner to loosen the track tension. The adjustment bolt close to the grease nipple)



5. Next, shorten the length of the front suspension assembly.



6. Put back the track on the suspension from the driving sprocket side. (Pay attention to the direction of the track.)



7. Push hard and rotate the track till it slides over the large bogey wheel, and then mount the large bogey wheel. Next, use a 13mm wrench to tighten 2 x M13 bolts.



8. Use a 10mm wrench to adjust the track tensioner to suitable track tensioner. Next, tighten the adjustment nut.
